2025 8U tryouts for current Second Graders* living in Winnetka, Glencoe, Northfield and Kenilworth will take place on February 21st and 22nd, 2025 at Illinois Baseball Academy – The Yard – in Northbrook (<u>www.illinoisbaseballacademy.com</u>).

* Players must be born after April 30, 2016, and must not turn 9 before May 1, 2025

To prepare for 8U tryouts, we have worked with Illinois Baseball Academy & The Yard to once again offer a 6-week tryout prep program catered to prospective 8U players!

This program is strongly encouraged but *not required* in order to attend 8U tryouts. Players who cannot participate in the 6-week tryout prep program may register for only the two-day tryout in February.

Players with conflicts are also welcome to contact IBA for private lesson availability. Please let them know you are preparing for 8U tryouts when inquiring.

<u>8U TRAVEL PROGRAM OVERVIEW</u>

- 2 teams of 11-12 players will be rostered.
- Players will participate in Spring House League Baseball via KWBA/GBA
- Teams will participate in 2 local tournaments NT Bulldog Classic over Memorial Day and the Lincolnshire Summer Slam in June.
- Teams enrolled in Lakeshore Feeder Baseball summer league. Approx. 14 games + playoffs. Ends Mid-July.
- Season concludes with 9U tryouts
